Regular decision, due January 15, 2012

- Common Application
 - Colgate Supplement (required)
 - \$60 application fee – The application fee is waived for students whose permanent mailing address is outside the U.S. Additionally, Colgate accepts official fee waivers from the College Board, the National Association for College Admission Counseling, and Expanding College Opportunities.
 - Official high school transcript and School Report, completed by your counselor
 - Home School Supplement (if applicable)
 - International School Supplement (optional)
 - Teacher Evaluations from two different teachers in major academic subjects (tenth, eleventh, or twelfth grade)
 - Personal Statement and Colgate essay (from Common Application and Colgate Supplement)
 - Standardized testing scores (either on official high school transcript or from a testing agency)
 - TOEFL scores, or alternate assessment of English skills
 - Mid-Year Grade Report including at least first quarter or first trimester senior grades, due in February or as soon as possible
 - Certified translation of official documents, when originals are not in English
